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Come Run...Come Cheer...Come Volunteer

On Saturday, February 11, 2006, the Grove will be hosting the 3rd annual Sweetheart 2M & 8K Race. Approximately 300 runners and walkers will participate in the annual event which features two races.

To register to run or walk, please visit www.rrrc.org.

The first race is a 2 mile loop that starts at 8am near the Grove Club House and ends on the Club House pond walking path. This short course appeals to a diverse running group of fast runners as well as many families and young runners.

The second race begins at 9:15 am and is an 8K (4.96 miles) run which features a new course that includes several Grove neighborhoods as well as the North Woolridge tunnel and portions of the miner's park trail. This new course also begins near the Grove Club House, and the final mile re-enters the Grove and winds through Gravity Hill Road, Goswick Ridge Court, Grove Hill Drive and also ends on the Club House pond walking path.

A copy of the actual course maps will be posted at the Club House and can be seen on the next page. All runners have been asked to park in designated areas and to avoid blocking driveways. Local police have been hired to assist with traffic control. This is an excellent opportunity to show case our beautiful community and neighborhoods! Richmond Road Runner's Club is a non-profit organization that promotes running and provides scholarships to local high school seniors.



The middle section of Grove Hill Road will be closed from approx. 7-11 AM on Saturday, Feb. 11th.






