An Annual Meeting of The Grove Homeowners Association was held on June 13, 2019. The meeting was held at The Grove Clubhouse, Midlothian, VA.

A. Welcome and Call to Order.

Gerry Mancuso called the meeting to order at 1835hrs.

B. Roll Call and Quorum Status.

John McGill made a motion to approve the Minutes for the 2019 Annual Meeting. John Romano 2nd. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

E. <u>Approval of Agenda</u>.

Ms. Mancuso made a motion to approve the Agenda for February 7, 2019. Matt Chafin 2nd. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

F. Introduction of Candidates.

Earl Nunnally, Ms. Mancuso, and Mr. Chafin each introduced themselves as candidates for the Board. There were no nominations from the floor. Mr McGill made a motion to close nominations. Josh Farmer 2nd. Motion passed by unanimous vote.

G. Election of Board Members.

Mr. Nunnally, Ms. Mancuso, and Mr. Chafin were each elected to the Board by receiving the largest number of votes. There were also three write-in candidates, each of whom received one vote.

- H. <u>President's Report</u>.
 - i. Ms. Mancuso thanked Board Members for their service to the community, and welcomed the homeowners in attendance.
 - ii. Ms. Mancuso described the breadth of the Board's responsibility, noting that The Grove Homeowners Association is comprised of 736 homes.
 - iii. Ms. Mancuso advised that, In 2019, the Grove Homeowners Association purchased new covers for pool.

- iv. Ms. Mancuso advised that the gray fence along Coalfield Road will be re-painted this month.
- v. Ms. Mancuso advised that the pool's parking lot will be paved and restriped this month.
- vi. Ms. Mancuso described other upcoming events.
- I. <u>Treasurer's Report</u>.

At the end of the 2018 calendar year, The Grove Homeowners Association had \$155,000.00 in cash on hand, \$265,565.00 in reserve funding, and \$7,947.00 in delinquent payments.

 - IV. A member requested an opportunity to meet directly with the ARC to discuss a request that had previously been made, but not acted upon by the ARC.
 - V. A member expressed concerns about playground improvements; urged the Board to ensure all improvements comply with current code requirements.
